Interpretation

The words for which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions: The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear singular or plural.

Definitions

For this privacy policy:

- **"Account"** means a unique account created for you to access our service or parts of our service.
- **"Company"** (referred to as either "the Company," "We," "Us," or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to [COMPANY INFORMATION].

- **"Cookies"** are small files a website places on your computer, mobile device, or any other device. They contain details of your browsing history on that website and are used for many purposes.

Collecting and Using Your Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

- Usage Data

Usage Data

Usage data is collected automatically when using the service.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g., IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Service by or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device's unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information your browser sends whenever you visit our service or access the service using a mobile device.

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our service and store certain information. Tracking technologies are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and improve and analyze our service. The technologies we use may include:

- **Cookies or browser cookies.** A cookie is a small file placed on your device. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may be unable to use some parts of our service. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our service may use cookies.
- **Web beacons.** Certain sections of our service and our emails may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of a specific section and verifying system and server integrity).

Cookies can be "persistent" or "session" cookies. Persistent cookies remain on your computer or mobile device when you go offline, while session cookies are deleted when you close your web browser.

We use both session and persistent cookies for the purposes set out below:

- **Necessary or Essential Cookies**
Type: session cookies
Administered by: Us

Purpose: These cookies are essential to providing you with services available through the website and enabling you to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these cookies, the services you have asked for cannot be provided, and we only use these cookies to provide you with those services.

- **Cookies Policy or Notice Acceptance Cookies**

Type: persistent cookies

Administered by: Us

Purpose: These cookies identify if users have accepted cookies on the website.

- **Functionality Cookies**

Type: Persistent cookies

Purpose: These cookies allow us to remember choices you make when you use the website, such as remembering your login details or language preference. The purpose of these cookies is to provide you with a more personal experience and to avoid having to re-enter your preferences every time you use the website.

- **Tracking and Performance Cookies**

Type: Persistent cookies

Administered by: Third Parties

Purpose: These cookies are used to track information about traffic to the website and how users use the website. The information gathered via these cookies may directly or indirectly identify you as an individual visitor. This is because the information collected is typically linked to a pseudonymous identifier associated with the device you use to access the website. We may also use these cookies to test new pages, features, or new functionality of the website to see how our users react to them.

Use of Your Data

The company may use personal data for the following purposes:

- **To provide and maintain our service**, including monitoring its usage.

- **For other purposes:** We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and evaluating and improving our service, products, services, marketing, and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

- **With Service Providers:** We may share Your personal information with Service Providers to monitor and analyze the use of our service for payment processing and to contact You.
- **For business transfers:** We may share or transfer Your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of Our business to another company.
- **With Affiliates:** We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this privacy policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or companies we control or are under common control.
- **With business partners:** We may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products, services, or promotions.
- **With other users:** When you share personal information or otherwise interact in public areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may be publicly distributed outside.
- **With Your consent:** We may disclose Your personal information for any other purpose with Your consent.

Retention of Your Data

The company will retain your data only for as long as necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We will retain and use Your Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The company will also retain usage data for internal analysis purposes. Usage data is generally retained for a shorter period, except when it is used to strengthen the security or improve our service's functionality or when we are legally obligated to retain it for more extended periods.

Transfer of Your Data

Your information, including personal data, is processed at the company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. This means that this information may be transferred to—and maintained on—computers outside your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws differ from yours.

Your consent to this privacy policy, followed by submitting such information, represents your agreement to that transfer.

The company will take all necessary steps to ensure your data is treated securely and follows this privacy policy. Data transfer will only occur to an organization or a country if adequate controls exist, including the security of your data and other personal information.

Disclosure of Your Data

Business Transactions
