Category	Public Organization	Private Organization
Purpose	Services for society (e.g., education, healthcare, safety).	Products/services for profit (e.g., selling goods, offering paid services).
Funding Source	Government funding, taxes	Sales, private investments
Accountability	Public, government, media, audits	Owners, shareholders, private audits
Main Goal	Benefit society, provide services	Make a profit, grow the business
Ownership	Owned by the government	Owned by individuals, groups, or companies
Type of Services Offered	Essential services (e.g., education, healthcare, public safety)	Commercial services (e.g., retail, hospitality, manufacturing)
Decision-Making Process	Often slower due to regulations and bureaucracy	Faster due to fewer regulations and more flexibility
Target Audience	Everyone in the society, regardless of income	Customers who can pay for products/services
