

Thumbnail Creation Checklist

1. Use a High-Quality Image
 - Choose a clear, high-resolution picture to make your thumbnail stand out.
2. Add Bold Text
 - Use short, bold, and easy-to-read text (3-5 words) to tell viewers what your video is about.
3. Choose Bright Colors
 - Pick colors that catch attention. Bright colors like red, yellow, and blue work well.
4. Keep it Simple
 - Don't overcrowd the thumbnail with too many details. Make sure it's clean and easy to understand.
5. Show Faces (if possible)
 - Thumbnails with faces attract more clicks, so include a face with an expressive look if it fits your video.
6. Use a Template
 - If you make lots of videos, use a design template to keep your thumbnails consistent.
7. Check for Mobile-Friendliness
 - Make sure your thumbnail looks good and is readable even on small screens like phones.
8. Test Different Designs
 - Create a few versions and see which one works best with your audience.
